- Primary School (Prep-Year 6)
- Middle School (Years 7–9)
- Senior School (Years 10–12)

We also offer Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) for students from Prep to age 12.

Our approach allows for smooth, confident transitions and a strong sense of belonging. At the same time, each stage of the journey provides fresh milestones, rewards and opportunities to help students grow and progress at every phase.





Prep Year: Setting off

Based on the Australian and Early Years Curriculum Guidelines, our Prep program ensures the best start possible, setting the scene for a happy and valuable experience throughout a child's schooling.

Catering for the distinctive needs of adolescents from Years 7 to 9, the Middle School delivers an engaging and targeted program designed to guide students through this crucial transitional phase.



The program:

- aims to help students adjust to sensitive and significant emotional, social and physical changes, and successfully transition through adolescence
- delivers a highly relevant curriculum, focussing on student-centred activities and exploring technologies
- fosters each student's individuality through inclusive teaching practices and a differentiated approach
- offers "The Rite Journey", a right of passage program specifically designed to prepare Year 9 students for the senior phase of learning and emerging adolescence
- provides many opportunities for peer group interaction and physical movement, emphasising collaborative decision-making to prepare them for the challenges ahead
- continues to foster the Habits of Mind, including flexibility, resilience and problem solving
- facilitates events and activities that appeal to this age group's sociable nature
- offers Gifted and Talented extension programs and Learning Support
